

Cherry Tree Class Miss Peck Curriculum Information Summer term 2024

#### Mathematics

- Explore 3D shapes
- Numbers to 20 and beyond
- Sharing and grouping
- Visualise, build and map.
- Making connections with maths around them.

The children are completing a range of practical activities and beginning to solve problems and explain their reasoning. There is a big focus on number formation and the children practise this on a regular basis.

#### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- participate in turn taking games
- listen to and take on board the ideas of others.
- try new activities and select resources independently especially within rainbow challenges.
- think about the feelings of others
- learn about ways to share their own feelings.
- think about occasions/events which are special to themselves or other people.
- talk about ways that they can keep themselves safe.
- talk about ways to keep

## Understanding the World-

- talk about similarities and differences between seaside holidays now and in the past.
- find seaside towns on the map.
- explore the natural world around them by identifying, making observations and drawing pictures of plants.
- Know some similarities and differences between the natural world around them and contrasting environments.

## **Physical Development**

- move with confidence, control and safety in dance and in team games.
- Develop their fine motor skills during finger gym.
- learn about a healthy lifestyle
- use a range of tools safely
- play group games
- use small and large equipment including gymnastics equipment in the hall.
- Swimming- 2<sup>nd</sup> half term.

#### Literacy

- Book focuses: The Lighthouse Keepers lunch, Sharing a shell, Toddle Waddle and Clean up.
- recognise and write their name
- listen to a range of fiction and non-fiction books
- daily phonics sessions- phase 3 and 4
- write familiar words in particular words with the sounds that they have learnt.
- write for a purpose
- re-tell stories that they have listened to.
- talk about characters in story books
- write simple sentences

# Expressive Arts and Design

- explore sounds and move to music
- play a variety of instruments
- look at the work of artist Andy Goldsworthy.
- sing familiar songs
- name and mix colours
- Explore and use a wide range of different materials.

## Communication and Language

- take part in circle time
- share ideas in front of a small group and the class with increasing confidence.
- ask and answer questions.
- talk about things that are important to them.
- listen to, and join in with, stories and rhymes.
